HISTORIAN'S BLUEBONNET AWARD

1. The Awards Committee shall judge all entries submitted.
2. In order to be eligible for the Bluebonnet Award, the scrapbook must be submitted by the deadline determined by the Committee Chair
3. The scrapbook receiving the highest number of points, (see attached criteria) will be awarded the Historian's Bluebonnet Award at the business meeting during the Annual State Conference
4. The winning district will receive a cash award, and a certificate will be presented to the first and second place winner
5. In the event of a tie, the TAPAN President will be asked to cast the deciding vote.
6. Each district is responsible for collecting their book from the TAPAN registration desk at the end of the judging period. Books not claimed are not the responsibility of the Awards Committee

GUIDELINES FOR THE BLUEBONNET AWARD

The district scrapbook receiving the highest number of points, as judged by the Awards Committee (see attached criteria) will receive The Bluebonnet Award.

1. Use any standard photograph album or scrapbook
2. Include a list of district officers and a group photograph
3. Showcase all of your district activities. Where possible, include the name and date of the activity and identify those district members involved.
4. Be creative! Mementos such as napkins, matchbook covers, postcards and photographs, as well as decorated pages can make your scrapbook interesting.

JUDGING CRITERIA FOR THE BLUEBONNET AWARD

The scrapbook will be judged based on three categories, using a numerical scale of 0 - 10, with 0 being low and 10 being high. Each member of the Historical Committee will be asked to rate every scrapbook and the scores will be totaled by the Chairperson. The scrapbook receiving the highest score will be awarded first prize, and the second highest scoring scrapbook will be named runner-up.
